

**WCA ALL-BREED BULL TEST 2011/2012**  
**Conditions of Consignment Acceptance**  
**Due October 1, 2011**

The below conditions are contractual. Failure to meet these conditions will result in rejection of the consignment at the test station and/or exclusion of the consignment from the sale at the sole discretion of Washington Cattlemen's Association (WCA).

1. Consignor must have entry form completed and fee paid (#4).<sup>1</sup>
2. Consignor must have \$800.00 feed, yardage and presale costs paid.(#5).
3. Bulls must be born between January 1 and March 31, 2011 (#8).
4. Bulls must meet breed requirements for registration. All breeds must be registered as purebred except (a) Simmental bulls, which must be at least 7/8 Simmental; and (b) Red Angus, which must be category 1A or 1B and at least 7/8 Red Angus. Bulls may be entered with pending status with only weaning data. **Registration papers must be received by the bull test management no later than December 1, 2011.** Bulls may not be cataloged and may not sell if registration papers are not received by that date (#9).
5. Consignor must be a current member of the WCA (#11).
6. Bulls must weigh 600 lbs off the truck (#12).
7. Bulls must have legible tattoos (#13).
8. Bulls must pass physical check (#14).
9. BVD test must be negative and lab verification due no later than October 1, 2011 (#16).
10. Consignor must provide inoculation records showing required inoculations given (#17).  
Tassels on the sheath should be trimmed prior to delivery (#17f)
11. Brand inspection and heath certificate required for out of state cattle. Washington State transportation form required for Washington Cattle at time of delivery.

Consignors must provide records to show they have met the foregoing rules and regulations before a bull will be accepted at the test station.

Should the bull have already been sold at the time breach of the conditions is discovered, Seller shall bear sole responsibility and liability (including attorney fees) for any actionable consequences of violation of the above conditions. Further, Seller shall release, hold harmless and indemnify WCA, its officers, employees and agents for any and all damages to third parties or otherwise.
